Approval of September 17, 2024 Minutes

Motion by Andrew Hargis, second by Stacey Maenhoudt to approve the September 17, 2024 Minutes, as presented. Motion carried. All in favor.

Presentation and Scoring of Additional Scenarios created from Community Feedback

Dr. Kelly presented five redistricting scenarios (A-3, B-3, C-3, D-3 and F-3) generated by the board-approved Geographic Information Systems (GIS) Analysis firm (Woolpert). The five scenarios were created from community feedback received thus far in the process. Advisory team members then worked in small groups to score each scenario based on the board-approved criteria.

Dr. Kelly noted that there will be opportunity for in-person community engagement at the upcoming Community Engagement Open Houses to be held on October 14, 2024 from 6:00-7:30 at Plaza Middle School and on October 15, 2024 from 6:00-7:30 at Lakeview Middle School.
