## July 29, 2021 Regular Board Meeting

The Park Hill Board of Education held its July 29, 2021 Regular Meeting at 6:30 p.m. in the Board Room at the District Office, 7703 NW Barry Rd., Kansas City, MO 64153.

### **Information – Presentation**

#### 7.1 Malware Attack Update

Derrick Unruh, Director of Technology, reported that outside experts confirmed what our internal experts had found – there was no evidence that any of our data was taken during the March malware attack. Mr. Unruh also shared that the district is continuing ongoing efforts to find ways to make our systems more secure.

#### 7.2 COVID-19 Update

Dr. Cowherd and Tammy Saylor, Director of Health Services provided the following update.

- Mask Update: Kansas City Mayor Quinton Lucas issued an order this week mandating masks indoors for everyone five and older in public places. The mask mandate goes from 12:01 a.m. Monday, August 2 through at least 12:01 a.m. on Saturday, August 28. This means everyone five and older in our Park

Hill School District facilities, whether or not they are fully vaccinated, must wear masks while this mandate is in effect.

- State Guidance: The state of Missouri provided school districts with guidance emphasizing in-person learning. During the 2021-2022 school year, the state will only allow schools to have five total distance learning days, for snow days, for COVID-19, or for any other reason
- COVID-19 in Park Hill: We had 15 positive cases of COVID-19 during summer school 2021, just as we had 15 positive cases back in summer school 2020. During the month of July, we've had 42 positive cases reported to us. Three of those cases were breakthrough cases. The Platte County Health Department shared with us that we have 169 cases per 100,000 people in our area as of this afternoon.


