Meeting Opening

1.1 Call to Order

2.1 Adoption of Agenda

Study Session Topics

3.1 LEAD Innovation Studio Construction Update

The Board received an update from Dr. Kelly, and representatives from Hollis + Miller, the District's architectural firm, on the design and construction of the LEAD Innovation Studio.

3.2 Middle School Transition Update

The Board received a written report from Dr. Jaime Dial, Director of Secondary Education, on the transition to four middle schools. Dr. Dial shared the four middle schools' extracurricular options, including sports and activities planned for the 2019-2020 and 2020-2021 school years.

3.3 APR (Annual Performance Reports) and Accountability Status Update

Dr. Kimbrel updated the Board on the state's annual performance report noting that Missouri delayed all APR scores because the state will release MAP test results later this winter. Dr. Kimbrel said the state expects to introduce a new evaluation system for schools at least two years from now. He also shared that Park Hill will receive ACT score data later this fall.


