Public Comment at Board Meetings

Excerpt from Board Policy BDDH

A specifically designated time will be set aside for public comments at regular meetings of the Board of Education. The following rules will be applied to the public comment portion of the meeting:

- The Board will establish a limit to the number of speakers or overall time for the public comment period.
- No individual will be permitted to speak more than once during this period.
- The Board will establish a uniform limit for each speaker.

Additional requirements for public comment are posted in the Board's meeting agenda.

Process and Format

Individuals wishing to provide public comment to the Board must pre-register no later than 12:00 p.m. (noon) on the day of the meeting using this link: <https://www.signupgenius.com/go/phsdpubliccomment>.

Registration will open 48 hours prior to the registration deadline (for a Thursday meeting, registration will open at 12:00 p.m. on Tuesday).

There will be a maximum of 7 speakers, and each speaker will have a 3-minute time limit.

Please direct your comments to the entire Board. Generally, Board members will not provide any response during public comment; however, if needed, Board members and/or district staff may provide a response at a later time. Discussion about individual staff members or students is not allowed.
